Short description	Pupils from Spain, France and Germany present each other their preferences, the sights of their places of residence and their ideas for the future

Aims	By getting to know Europeans of the same age, the pupils should train their intercultural communication skills. They acquire communicative competence in foreign languages by choosing from the different foreign languages English, French and Spanish as appropriate to the situations. They adopt a change of perspective by presenting sights and features of their places of residence. This is how the pupils experience Europe.

<p>Work process</p>	<p>Tri-national teams will be formed before the start of the project and will work together for the duration of the project.</p> <p>The project consists of three phases.</p> <p>In the first phase, the students get to know each other in the small groups. They present each other, their hobbies, preferences, school contexts and visions for the future.</p> <p>In the second phase, the focus is then placed on the place of residence. Within the groups, the pupils present their places of residence to each other from different points of view, such as tourist attractiveness, cultural diversity, climate protection, etc.</p> <p>The cooperation with the partner schools will be digitally supported in the first two phases.</p> <p>In the third phase, a physical exchange will be planned. For this, the tri-national groups undertake various organisational processes and thus plan their time together.</p> <p>The joint work on the project will be about one hour per week.</p>
<p>Expected results</p>	<p>As a result, a public Twinspace is to be created.</p> <p>The results of the third project phase are used to organise the physical exchange and have a direct influence on the planning and implementation during the visits of the other groups on site.</p>
