Short description	Croatian and German pupils learn about different aspects of viticulture in Germany and Croatia.
Languages	English, German
Numbers of pupils	8 (from Croatia), 8 (from Germany)
Age	16 - 17 years
Subjects	Cross curricular, foreign languages, biology, chemistry, economics
Vocational subjects	Agriculture, business and marketing, catering and tourism, food industries
Key competences	Language and cultural awareness and expression, digital, entrepreneurship
Aims	Pupils learn about different areas of viticulture by becoming experts in the fields of viticulture and harvesting, wine marketing, the consequences of climate change on viticulture and the history of viticulture in the region. They acquire this knowledge in contrast to Germany and Croatia. They also acquire intercultural skills by communicating with people of the same age from Germany and Croatia. They use English as a lingua franca.
Work process	The project consists of three phases. In the first phase, the students work digitally. They choose a topic according to their own interests, on which they acquire expert

	<p>knowledge. The topic is worked on in binational tandems so that the pupils get to know each other during the learning process.</p> <p>The physical exchange takes place in the second phase. First, the German group travels to Croatia, followed by a return visit to Germany one month later. Learning opportunities are created through numerous topic-related activities on site.</p> <p>In the third phase, the final product is presented. Each tandem presents its learning outcomes and evaluates the development process. In addition to an oral presentation, the presentation also takes place in the Twinspace.</p> <p>The joint work on the project will be about one hour per week.</p>
Expected results	<p>The expected results are various presentations on specific topics in the field of viticulture. The presentations will consist of an oral presentation (which can also be recorded) and a final product in Twinspace.</p> <p>This Twinspace will be made public in the third phase so that the school community can also benefit from the expert knowledge.</p>
